CONDITIONAL PERMIT TO USE CONDUIT AND RIGHT OF WAY

Permission is hereby granted to ARNOLD J. FOLLETT of Route 5, Wenatchee, Washington to construct, operate, maintain a 4" steel domestic water line in a 12" plain concrete pipe conduit under and across PHS No. 10 at approximately H.E.S. 232/12, East Wenatchee to Rock Island, Section 1 in Douglas County. The crossing is also located in Government Lot 1, Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 21 E.W.M.

It is specifically understood that a condition and limitation of this permit is that the permittee shall at all times be subject and limited by the conditions of the master permit herein between the East Wenatchee Water District and the Washington State Department of Highways, being permit No. 2036 CS 0901, dated May 22, 1959, all of which terms and conditions the permittee agrees to abide by.

FURTHER AND IN ADDITION, the permittee shall save and hold harmless at all times the Water District from any harm or damage occurring to any person or property as a result of all connections with the permittees use of the conduit for his purposes.

The Permittee shall promptly repair or remove his installed line at any time the East Wenatchee Water District may give notice to so do for any reason whatsoever, it being specifically a condition of this permit, that it is terminable and revocable at any time by the Water District. In the event of a notice to remove given to the permittee by the Water District, or in the event of his failure or inability to act upon the removal of any pipe or facilities, the permittee agrees to pay all reasonable costs for removal and repair as occasioned thereby.
