

RESOLUTION NO. 161

AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has recently developed a substantial new domestic water well; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of heavy duty and extensive testing require a certain type of unusual well screen, not anticipated or anticipatable at the time of the initiation of the testing, and

WHEREAS, the District has contacted all of the suppliers and manufacturers of such well screens by telephone to determine the lowest possible quote on such a piece of equipment, and it is extremely urgent that such piece of equipment be ordered and installed at the earliest possible moment and a true emergency existing, demanding that it be immediately ordered, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, that the Office Manager is hereby authorized to order and pay for a sixteen (16) inch stainless steel well screen from the lowest possible bidder who can supply such screen at the earliest moment, and that the conditions and requirements for this screen are determined to be and are hereby declared to be an emergency and the Office Manager is authorized to order such supplies without formal bidding procedures.
