

RESOLUTION NO. 182

A POLICY ON EXPANSION OF THE WATER SYSTEM BEYOND NILE STREET

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is unable at this time to adequately supply the water users in the area East of Nile Street, and,

WHEREAS, many persons would seek to build in the area beyond Nile Street, and

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District may at some future time be able to provide water beyond Nile Street, and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, no water meters will be sold to persons wishing to build beyond Nile Street from April 1, 1977 until the District determines that there is adequate water and supply system to properly serve new customers, however,


WHEREAS, in view of the obvious hardship such a policy imposes on those persons who have already commenced building on completed steps preliminary thereto, the Commissioners authorize the Manager to make exceptions to the "no extension" policy so long as the applicant falls within the following guidelines:

1. The applicant has an interest in land beyond Nile Street and had said interest prior to April 1, 1977, and
2. The applicant had applied for a building permit prior to April 1, 1977, or
3. The applicant had been informed by a speaking agent of the East Wenatchee Water District or of the Douglas County Planning office that water would be available.

Said information to be reduced to a written affidavit and signed by either the speaking agent, or the person to whom the representation was made, and


4. A showing that the applicant had determinately relied on that representation.
