AUTHORIZING MANAGER TO TAKE NECESSARY  
STEPS TO SEEK NEW ENGINEERING FIRM

WHEREAS, after extensive research has been done by the District to consider the possibility of obtaining the services of another engineering firm, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that the present engineering firm of Gray & Osborne, Yakima, Washington is not serving the District's needs, and


WHEREAS, it is further felt that the hourly rates the District is paying Gray & Osborne is exorbitant, in addition, the District must pay 12¢ per mile travel time as well as per diem, meals, and lodging for their services, and

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, Douglas County, Washington that it has been deemed in the best interest of the District to authorize the manager to take necessary steps to consider the possibility of obtaining the services of another engineering firm. Said decision to be discussed and acted upon at a regular board meeting before a final decision is made by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District.
