

RESOLUTION NO. 270

AMENDMENTS TO RESOLUTIONS No. 157 and 205  
"Establishing Extension Costs"

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District have previously established various rates from time to time for pipeline extensions, improvements or upgrading, and

WHEREAS, said rates have not been able to fairly and accurately reflect the increased costs for making new extensions for subdivision developers, for new lines or for upgrading existing lines to meet new services, and

WHEREAS, it appears reasonable and necessary to establish a new formula consistent with the actual cost involved and to allow for reasonable planning by the District and any prospective developer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, that all pipeline extensions, whether new line or for replacement or upgrading of existing lines to serve additional demand, shall be at the direct cost of man hours, machinery, overhead expense, and will add a twenty percent (20%) above cost on all materials. Such costs shall be borne by the individual or company applying for such service, and all of which charges shall be paid or properly arranged for prior to initiation of work or service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or rate policies inconsistent with this Resolution No. 270 and prior to this date are hereby revoked.
