

RESOLUTION NO. 274

ESTABLISHING A SET FEE FOR FIRE FLOW PROTECTION

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has not in the past, established a set fee in providing fire flow protection for various business' as requested from time to time, and


WHEREAS, in certain areas of the District, water mains are adequate to afford such protection as requested, and

WHEREAS, having checked with the Chelan County Public Utility District Water System, it was determined that a fee of \$900.00 was charged to the individual or firm making such request, plus a bi-monthly charge ranging from \$20.00 to \$42.00, depending on the size of main available, and

WHEREAS, it is believed that it is ⁱⁿ the best interest of the District that a fee should be assessed for future connection to provide the necessary maintenance and replacement costs of doing business.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that a fee of \$900.00 will be charged to any or all individuals who request to connect to an existing main line, and furthermore, a detector - checkvalve will be required, prior to cutting in any or all water mains. Said service or request will be performed entirely by Water District personnel, commensurate with the hourly rate schedule as previously adopted.

ADOPTED this 20th day of August 1979, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
