

RESOLUTION NO. 302

ESTABLISHING EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING POLICIES

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has Job Classifications on various levels that require training and certain expertise to fill those positions for certain employees, officers, or management personnel to improve or extend their skills and abilities and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the District to provide for the training and continued education of their existing personnel or such personnel as the District may hire for a specific position in the future and,

WHEREAS, the costs of such training, schooling or other specified education should be born by the District as a cost operation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington shall pay the cost of various courses, seminars, training sessions and similar educational endeavors, as may be approved by the Board from time to time upon application by any such employee, officer or board member, with the stipulation that said personnel shall receive a passing grade and in the event they do not obtain a satisfactory or passing grade, the District shall be reimbursed the actual costs incurred.
