CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF LID #7 - FROM GREATER WENATCHEE IRRIGATION TO EAST  
WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT


COMES NOW the Board of Commissioners of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT and does resolve as follows:

1. On October 5, 1981, the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT assumed full ownership rights and responsibility for LID #7, a domestic water system previously within the jurisdiction and control of the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District.


2. The property contained within the boundaries of LID #7 is largely undeveloped and the existing domestic water system is in need of upgrading and periodic maintenance and repair. Therefore, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that anyone seeking to connect onto this existing water system in LID #7 or any additions thereto, shall be assessed a onetime connection charge of \$1,150.00.

3. In addition to the above-described connection charge, any citizen seeking to purchase a water meter within the LID #7 district boundary will be charged the normal fee for a meter, which at this time is \$500.00 but is subject to change, and a plant investment fee of \$300.00, which fee is also subject to change.
