

RESOLUTION NO. 314

AUTHORIZING INCREASE IN EXCESS WATER USAGE

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District's consulting engineering firm has just completed a new Comprehensive Plan for the District, and in the Plan several items have been recommended regarding the steps the District should take in updating its distribution system and,


WHEREAS, additional revenues can be obtained by initiating a rate increase on the excess water consumed by the District users and,

WHEREAS, such a program would enable the District to consummate a number of Capital Improvements as recommended in the Comprehensive Plan without initiating a base rate increase to the general public and,

WHEREAS, after much consideration it is deemed to be in the best interest of the East Wenatchee Water District to raise the rates for excess water and thereby allow the District to pursue the Comprehensive Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, Douglas County, Washington, that effective January 4, 1982 the rate for all excess water used above 600 C.F. per month, shall be \$.45 for each 100 C.F. consumed.

ADOPTED, this 18th day of January 1982, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
