

RESOLUTION NO. 324

ESTABLISHING A TIME LIMIT ON SALE OF METER INSTALLATIONS


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has previously established by Resolution a fee for the installation of water meters according to size and,

WHEREAS, the District has not established a time limit for the installation of meter, commensurate with the purchase price and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deem it to be in the best interest of the District to establish a time limit because of a possible price increase from the time of purchase to the actual installation.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, effective immediately, all water meters sold to a potential or future customer shall be installed within a four (4) month period, or 120 days and if water meter is not installed within the above time period, the customer will be refunded the actual amount of money at that time of purchase.

ADOPTED, this 20th day of June 1983, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof.
