WHEREAS, the Economic Development Council's primary function is the preservation of existing, and the creation of new jobs in North Central Washington and,


WHEREAS, growth in the area will create new jobs and increase the tax base as well as improve economic stability while maintaining the quality of life enjoyed by all who reside here and,

WHEREAS, the Council must rely on outside funds and membership dues in order to be self-supporting and,


WHEREAS, a general membership dues currently paid by the East Wenatchee Water District is \$125.00 per year and,

As directed, we have checked all extensions and additions contained in the bids received on the subject project.

We have also obtained verbal agreement from the utilities involved as to a formula for dividing the costs of the shared trenches. The total unit price bids are distributed below:

GTE	5,411.14	(3% of Total Contract)
GWC-TV	<u>1,858.91</u>	(1% of Total Contract)
TOTAL	\$187,072.40	


I have verbally notified each utility as to their share of the construction cost and have received verbal approval from each one.

As a result of the above, we recommend award of the subject contract to Selland Construction Company for their low unit price bid of \$187,072.40.
