

RESOLUTION NO. 334

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF DISTRICT COMPUTER

WHEREAS, the present computer owned by the East Wenatchee Water District, is no longer adequate to serve the needs of the District and,


WHEREAS, the present computer was purchased in January 1980, and the mechanical working parts and service repairs is becoming more difficult to replace and obtain in order to keep the machine performing at a level to meet the District's needs and,

WHEREAS, the District has spent considerable time in obtaining quotes for other machines, to include a price range from \$46,500 to \$33,500 that would best serve the District's needs, to include two days spent in the Seattle area evaluating various machines at sever different Water District's and,


WHEREAS, after carefully weighing all factors, to include service maintenance, it is believed that the Cado Computer is designed to best serve the District's needs now as well as those of the future.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that the manager is hereby authorized to proceed with the purchase of the Cado Computer, to include all necessary software, for the purchase price of \$37,550 including Washington State Sales Tax.
