

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING STATION WITH
ASSOCIATED VALVES, VAULT AND WATER MAIN

WHEREAS, the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT included in it's 1991 budget, four major projects, which are identified in the five year Comprehensive Plan, projects that would be bid by contractors on the Small Works Roster and,

WHEREAS, one of the projects, a Pressure Reducing Station with associated valves, vault and approximately 200 feet of water main was engineered by the District's engineer, ready to call for bids and,

WHEREAS, Water District personnel attended a joint meeting with the Public Works Department on June 25th, only to be informed that an asphalt overlay of the street where said Pressure Reducing Station and pipe is to be installed would have to be completed by July 12th, thereby creating a severe hardship on the Water District, in obtaining bids from various contractors and,

WHEREAS, the manager and the District's engineer contacted one contractor, namely Selland Construction Company to see if they could submit a bid and complete the project by July 12th, only to be informed that by the time they reviewed the plans and specifications, obtained the necessary bonding, the time schedule given would be such that they were not comfortable and,


WHEREAS, after re-evaluating the matter with the District's engineer, knowing well that it would be difficult to obtain a qualified contractor to complete this project within the time given, coupled with the fact that Douglas County Public Works will not permit utilities to open cut newly paved streets or roads for a five year period, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Water District to declare this project as an Emergency and proceed to complete the project in a timely manner with District personnel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that Resolution No. 388 is hereby declared an Emergency and further authorizes the manager to proceed with District personnel to accomplish whatever needs to be done, prior to the overlay of asphalt on the County road.

ADOPTED, this 1st day of July 1991, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
