

**RESOLUTION NO. 422**

**AUTHORIZING INCREASE IN MONTHLY BASE WATER RATES,  
AS WELL AS INCREASE OF EXCESS USAGE**

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the future needs of the District, the Board of Water Commissioners of the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District that certain additions to and betterment's and extensions of the existing water supply and distribution system be made, and

WHEREAS, the existing rates are not adequate to address the betterment's and improvements, as well as meet the bond payments and debt service of the District and meet the projected increased population to serve its present customers of the District, and


WHEREAS, the amendments to the Safe Water Drinking Act has created an additional expense to the District in order to meet the necessary requirements as directed by both the Department of Health and the Environmental Protection Agency, and

WHEREAS, the District has expended considerable revenues over the past two years in drilling two wells for a new source of water to meet the future demands to serve its customers and will be required to replace much of its present infrastructure and this further substantiates why it is prudent to initiate a rate increase at this time to adjust our revenues to allow for future replacement, and

WHEREAS, after much consideration and reviewing the future needs of the District, the Board of Water Commissioners deem it to be in the best interest of the Water District to increase the Base Rate, as well as the Excess Usage, thereby allowing the District to pursue the betterment's and improvements that will be identified in the new Comprehensive Plan, which is presently being prepared by the District's consulting engineer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners, that effective January 1st, 1995, the Base Rate for 600 C.F. of water consumed shall be \$11.00 per month and for all Excess Water used above 600 C. F. per month, shall be \$.65 cents for each 100 C. F. consumed.

ADOPTED, this 15th day of December, 1994 by the BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
