RESOLUTION NO. 485

**AWARD DUCTILE IRON PIPE PURCHASE FOR YEAR 2000
PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having complied with R.C.W. 57.08.050 in calling for bids to install water mains and other system improvements to the District's water system, and

WHEREAS, the projects are identified in the District's 1996 Comprehensive Water System Plan, and

WHEREAS, specifications were prepared by the District's engineer for said projects, and the supplier will furnish the materials F.O.B. East Wenatchee, and

WHEREAS, the purchase of ductile iron pipe at this time is beneficial to the District due to a price war between the ductile iron pipe foundries, and

WHEREAS, the District received four bids to install ductile iron pipe for the year 2000 projects as follows:

<u>PACIFIC STATES CAST IRON PIPE CO.</u>	\$454,863.60	Sales Tax Excluded
<u>GRIFFIN PIPE</u>	\$463,224.85	Sales Tax Excluded
<u>AMERICAN DUCTILE IRON PIPE</u>	\$603,107.20	Sales Tax Excluded
<u>US PIPE & FOUNDRY</u>	\$633,505.80	Sales Tax Excluded

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids, and therefore it is recommended that the lowest bid in the amount of \$454,863.60, excluding sales tax, be awarded to Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Co., and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that the low bid in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Four Thousand, Eight Hundred Sixty Three Dollars and Sixty Cents is hereby awarded to Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Co. of Renton, WA, and the General Manager is authorized to execute and do all acts necessary with reference to this award.
