

RESOLUTION NO. 639

AWARD 2012 1170 ZONE BOOSTER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the 1170 Zone Booster System project generally described as follows:

Construction of pipe, valves and electrical systems to service one 30 hp vertical multistage centrifugal and one 75 hp vertical turbine pump inside the District's existing Regional Booster Station. Pumps will be supplied by others. Motor control centers will be provided by the District, to be installed under this contract.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's engineer for the above described project and the successful contractor will furnish all the necessary equipment and materials to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, the District received two bids (prices include sales tax) to install said facilities as follows:

Columbia Energy	\$93,844.85
Pipkin Const	\$131,882.00

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids, and therefore it is recommended by the District's engineer that the lowest responsible bid be awarded to Columbia Energy in the amount of \$93,844.85, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the lowest responsible bid from Columbia Energy in the amount of ninety three thousand, eight hundred forty four and eighty five cents is hereby accepted and a contract for the project will be executed with Columbia Energy of Richland, Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.

ADOPTED, this 1st day of August 2012, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
