

RESOLUTION NO. 820

RESOLUTION AWARD GRANT ROAD METER SERVICES 2024

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the East Wenatchee Water District Grant Road Water Service Replacements generally described as follows:

Installation of approximately 40 water services and hdpe service lines tapped into the existing water main, abandoning existing corporation stops, fire hydrants with hot taps to the existing main and sidewalk, landscaping and HMA restoration.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's Engineer for the above-described project and the successful contactor will furnish all the necessary equipment and material to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2024, the District received five bids(including sales tax) to install said facilities as follows:

Capstone Structures LLC	\$572,560.93(withdrew bid)
Excavation West	\$625,677.04
Smith Excavation	\$667,890.00
Pipkin Construction	\$704,716.26
Selland Construction	\$851,874.70

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's Engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids and therefore it is recommended by the District's Engineer that the most responsible bid be awarded to Excavation West for the amount of \$625,677.04, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the most responsible bid from Excavation West in the amount of six hundred twenty five thousand, six hundred seventy seven dollars and four cents be awarded to Excavation West from Sedro Wolley, Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.
